Spring Conference, University of Central Oklahoma

- President Jennifer Ivie (Tulsa Community College) called the meeting to order at 3 p.m. She thanked the host school University of Central Oklahoma and the conference sponsor Scantron, represented at the conference by Jorge Quintana.

- Treasurer Susannah Livingood (University of Oklahoma) gave treasurer's reports for academic year 2018-19 and academic year 2019-20 with a PowerPoint presentation. She explained that relatively large balance was being accumulated in the event that the organization wanted to schedule a national speaker.
- Larry Burns (Oklahoma State University) made a motion to approve both of the treasurer's reports. Scheideler seconded the motion. The motion was approved by unanimous voice vote.
- Ivie announced that at least two board members' terms of office expire this year and called for volunteers to serve on the board.
- Patrick Kubier (University of Central Oklahoma) volunteered to be nominated as webmaster. Tiffany Bryant (University of Central Oklahoma) and Kirstin Krug (Southern Nazarene University) also volunteered to be nominated as board members.
- Livingood made a motion to approve the slate of nominees, and Isabelle Billen (Rose State College) seconded the motion. The motion was approved by unanimous voice vote.
